

**Charlotte County Public Schools

Summary

1. The District will take the following actions to partner with parents:
 - The District SAC Committee will develop, review annually and revise the District Title I Parent Involvement Plan.
 - The District notifies parents of a variety of opportunities to partner with the school to support their child's education.
 - The District Title I staff provides training to staff at each elementary school on the importance of involving parents in all levels of partnership.
 - Title I schools provide training throughout the year to parents regarding their role as their child's "first and most important teacher" and provides them with ways they can support learning in the home.
 - The District provides funds to support parental involvement to increase student achievement at both the district and school level.
 - The District provides resources to involve all families including those with limited English proficiency and disabilities.

2. The District provides support to assist the Title I schools in planning and implementing parent involvement activities in the schools.
 - Principals are provided with materials and strategies for engaging families.
 - Parent Involvement staff from each school attend monthly meetings to share strategies and to receive training on ways to partner with families to increase student achievement.

3. The District partners with other programs, such as Head Start, Early Head Start and Even Start, to increase parent involvement.
