

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

The way we dress influences our attitude about ourselves and our work. When students are dressed appropriately for school, they know it's time to learn. Our uniform dress code policy will provide students with a feeling of pride, unity, and school spirit.

Students at SJES may wear the following clothing to school:

- Neat fitting navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers or Capri pants with no visible printing or logos. No jeans of any color are allowed.
- Collared knit button or snap polo shirts in red, orange, white, or navy blue with no visible printing or logo (except the school's logo). Shirts may be long-sleeved or short-sleeved. Spirit shirts or AR shirts are allowed on Fridays with uniform bottoms.
- Closed-toe, rubber-soled shoes (e.g., tennis shoes) and matching socks that are school colors or black.

Windbreakers, fleece, sweater or sweatshirt-type jackets or pull-overs in red, orange, white, or navy blue with no visible printing or logo (except the school logo) if worn in the classroom. Neat fitting sweat pants in appropriate colors are acceptable. All other jackets or coats brought into the classroom must be placed in the area designated by the teacher.
