



Charlotte Virtual School Recommended Enrollment Criteria



Elementary Students

- 1) For students enrolling in Kindergarten:
Students will take FLKRS assessment with 30 days of the start of school.
- 2) For students enrolling in Grades 1-5:
Successful completion of the previous grade.

Secondary Students

- 1) Successful promotion from the previous grade. For entrance at the mid-point of the school year, passing grades in the first semester grade level core classes (English/language arts, math, science, social studies). CVS does not offer credit recovery.
- 2) Proficient scores on Florida State Assessments (FSA, EOCAs)
Grade level proficiency on an official standardized test administered by another state public school system
Homeschool students (portfolio review, if there are no assessment scores)

12th Grade Students

Enrollment in the 2018/2019 cohort or later

Proficient scores on 10th grade FSA ELA and Algebra 1 or Geometry EOC

Successful course completion of:

- 3 credits of English**
- 3 credits of math (including Algebra 1 and Geometry)**
- 2 credits of science**
- 2 credits of social science**
- Minimum 2.0 GPA**

What happens next?

Due to the rigor of this virtual learning modality, every application will be evaluated with the purpose of student educational growth. Once your application has been reviewed and your child is recommended for CVS, you will receive an email confirmation. If your student does not meet the “recommended” criteria for this school choice option, we will contact you to provide guidance based on your student’s academic history and educational goals in order for your family to make an informed decision.
