A message from Deelynn Bennett, Principal of CVS:

Good evening Charlotte Virtual School families!! This is Deelynn Bennett, Principal of Charlotte Virtual School. You are receiving this call because you have a student currently enrolled in Charlotte Virtual School. By now, you should have received a message from our Superintendent, Mr. Steve Dionisio. As his message explained, Charlotte County Public Schools has recognized the need for new flexibility within the three instructional delivery options of Brick and Mortar, Charlotte Virtual School, and Homeschool; therefore, the District has created a “new” model within each of the current instructional options. This new model is called the Innovative E-Learning Model.

By choosing the Innovative E-Learning Virtual Option, your student would reenroll to their home zoned school in their ***existing schedule and learning management system from which they are currently learning***. If you like the flexibility of a Charlotte Virtual school day from which you are currently learning, we recommend you stay with CVS. The only changes that would take place for the student would include:

- Virtual instruction will hold to traditional class size in the core.
- The virtual teachers would be able to offer additional support services to accommodate individual needs of students in a student-centered flexible environment.
- Students enrolled in the Innovative Virtual Learning Model would have more interaction with their instructors and would have more connections to their home zoned school with respect to school activities and school culture.
- This option would also allow students to graduate from their home zoned school. Currently full-time CVS students will graduate from Charlotte Virtual School.

You must make this decision beginning this evening following this call, and finalize your selection not later than midnight on Wednesday, September 23. Students will not officially enroll in this environment until Monday October 5th; however, it is important to note that they must continue working and progressing in their courses as nothing will change for the student during the transition.
