

How to Access the Family Portal Charlotte County Public Schools

The new Family Portal provides a central location for your student's assessment results.



The Family Portal can be used to

- access your student's results for the following state assessments: ELA & Math Assessments, Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology 1, Civics, and U.S. History
- print score reports.

How can I access the Family Portal?

- By clicking on the FOCUS Parent Portal landing page for each student you will find a direct link to the Florida Statewide Assessment Family Portal.

- Your child's results from the state test administration regardless of the present school of enrollment. *Note- If new to our district from another Florida district, these reports will be available after a few months.*
