



*A Message from Kristy Johnson, Director of ESE
To Families and Students on Access Point Instruction*

Good evening parents and guardians. This is Kristy Johnson, Director of ESE, with Charlotte County Public Schools. You are receiving this call because you have a student with an IEP prescribing Access Point Instruction. By now, you should have received a message from our Superintendent, Mr. Steve Dionisio. As his message explained, Charlotte County Public Schools has recognized the need for new flexibility within the three instructional delivery options of Brick and Mortar, Charlotte Virtual School, and Homeschool. Therefore, the District has created a “new” model within each of the current instructional options. This new model is called the E-Learning Model and provides an opportunity for students to reenroll or stay enrolled at his or her assigned school and engage in a virtual learning environment. CCPS has created an instructional environment that is geared to learners who require a modified curriculum and more ESE related supports than what Charlotte Virtual School can provide. If your student is working toward Access Points and is currently enrolled at CVS or at a Brick and Mortar School, you have the opportunity to enroll in the new E-Learning model. Your reelection window opens on September 17th and closes on September 23rd.

Parents or Guardians wishing to declare their intent to enroll their children into this new E-Learning option are required to complete the short survey on the ESE Webpage Titled, “ESE Innovative Learning Re-Election Form”, by the September 23rd deadline.

Again, we feel it is essential that the opportunity now exist to re-evaluate the option of your chosen instructional pathway for your children. Our goal is to keep learning moving forward. Flexibility and resiliency are needed during these difficult times, and we hope that this new option for your family will assist in our overall plans to close achievement gaps and accelerate student success.
