Good afternoon Charlotte County Public School Parents and Guardians of students ages **5 to 11**. This is Dr. Desjardins, Assistant Superintendent of School Support, with a brief message regarding voluntary student vaccinations. Once again, this message is only for the parents of students ages **5 to 11**.

The Charlotte County Department of Health is offering voluntary vaccinations for students ages 5 to 11 on Saturday, November 20th, at the following school locations: LA Ainger Middle School (Englewood), Murdock Middle School (Port Charlotte) and at Punta Gorda Middle School (Punta Gorda). Vaccinations will occur from 8am to 1pm.

This Saturday vaccination event is reserved for CCPS Students ages **5 to 11**. The DOH will be administering the Pfizer vaccine, which is a CDC approved vaccine for individuals under the age of 12.

Once again, this voluntary vaccination opportunity is open to all CCPS Students who are **5 to 11** years of age on November 20th from 8am to 1pm.

The Department of Health requires that a legal guardian accompany their student to this event and bring a completed Covid-19 Vaccine Consent Form.

Additionally, the Department of Health will also be providing covid-19 booster shots (Moderna & Johnson) for any adult meeting the requirement who wishes to receive a booster. It is important to note that adults unable to attend this event are still able to obtain their booster shots at local pharmacies throughout Charlotte County and the surrounding areas.
