Eagle Pride Behavior - Classroom Rules

1. Follow directions quickly.
2. Raise your hand for permission to speak.
3. Raise your hand for permission to leave your seat.
4. Make smart choices.

All students are expected to model "Eagle Pride" behavior by respecting others, their space, and property, showing manners to all students and adults, and always trying to do your best at everything you do.

Discipline Plan: Classroom discipline will follow the school discipline plan of Clip It Up/Down. Students will learn the rules during the first two weeks of school. They will clip up or down when they exhibit behavior requiring their clip to move.

- Students begin on Think About It (Yellow, 3) and once they copy their agenda they will clip up to Ready to Learn (Green, 4) making good choices or exceptional leader choices will keep their clip on Ready to Learn or move up to (Blue, 5) or Great Day, (Pink, 6) or Way to Go, and (Purple, 7) Outstanding Leader. If students go above and beyond students will clip "Off The Richter" and I will wear their clip for the remainder of the day!
- Students making choices that are not acceptable move their clip down to Think About It (Yellow), Time Out/Parent Contact (Orange) or Office Referral (Red)

Parents will be notified of student behavior every day in their Eagle Organizer.

Buddy Teacher: Ms. Mearns Room 154: Any student that is disrupting the class and needs a time out can be escorted to my buddy teacher.
