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## Class Description

**7<sup>th</sup> grade math\* focuses on the following:** \*Course description taken from cPalms

- (1) Developing an understanding of and applying proportional relationships.
- (2) Developing an understanding of operations with rational numbers and working with expressions and linear equations.
- (3) Solving problems involving scale drawings and informal geometric constructions, and working with two- and three-dimensional shapes to solve problems involving area, surface area, and volume.
- (4) Drawing inferences about populations based on samples.

## Class Supplies

## Absences

Missing one day of class will likely put your child behind in math by two or more days. If your child is sick/contagious or displaying ANY COVID-19 symptoms they should stay home. Please contact the school about their absence, then visit my teacher webpage for work.

Before allowing your child to stay home for other reasons, please remember that student success is directly related to time spent in class. All assignments will be posted to my teacher webpage for at-home completion. It is your responsibility, as the student, to see what assignments, notes, etc...you missed while you were absent from class. It is also your responsibility, as the student, to complete and turn in any missed assignments in a timely manner.

## Grades

Students will be graded using a total points system. Under this system, all assignments will be given a predetermined point total which will count towards the overall quarter grade. Grades will be posted in FOCUS 1-2 times per week. Parents and students should check FOCUS on a regular basis. Any late work may be penalized. There will be an opportunity to earn extra points throughout the school year and, you will be encouraged to take advantage of these opportunities.

## Homework

Homework is an at-home assignment that will reinforce the concepts taught in class. Homework assignments will not be accepted late. Homework assignments will be posted in class and on my teacher webpage daily.

## Math Enrichment

Math enrichment will be offered from 7:50-8:50 AM one day a week and 4:10-5:00 PM two days a week. The goal is to refine your child's math skills. Students will be permitted to retake any quiz or test from the current marking period. In order to qualify, a student must stay two days in a row. The first day for extra help on a concept and the second day to reassess the skill. If your child is not a walker, please have their ride scheduled to arrive no later than 5:00 PM.

## Remind remind

The Remind app was designed to enhance parent-teacher communication. This app allows notifications of important information and communication via text message. Parent/guardians can initiate conversations with the teacher as well as respond to class notifications.
